TINDALL HAMMOCK IRRIGATION AND SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION No. 2020-06

RESOLUTION OF THE TINDALL HAMMOCK IRRIGATION AND SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY ENTERPRISE FUND BUDGET OF THE TINDALL HAMMOCK IRRIGATION AND SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT (A/K/A FERN CREST UTILITY ENTERPRISE FUND BUDGET) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021 COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Tindall Hammock Irrigation and Soil Conservation District is a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Tindall Hammock Irrigation and Soil Conservation District (the "District") has acquired the utility assets of Fern Crest Utilities, Inc., and is providing water and wastewater utility service to the public; and

WHEREAS, the District established a public utility and enterprise fund a/k/a Fern Crest Utility Enterprise Fund to provide water and wastewater utility service to the former customers of the Fern Crest Utilities, Inc., utility systems and all current and future customers of the District's public utility; and

WHEREAS, District has published a notice of virtual public hearing by Communications Media Technology ("CMT") for September 16, 2020 at 4:45 P.M. on the District's proposed water and wastewater utility enterprise fund budget for fiscal year 2020/2021; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to establish, and amend from time to time, a budget for providing utility services by the District's utility system; and

WHEREAS, a virtual public hearing on the Tindall Hammock Irrigation and Soil Conservation District's proposed final water and wastewater utility enterprise fund budget for fiscal year 2020/2021 was held at 4:45 P.M. on Tuesday, the 16th day of September, 2020 by CMT.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Tindall Hammock Irrigation and Soil Conservation District in meeting assembled, that:

- 1. The District's final water and wastewater utility enterprise fund budget for the fiscal year 2020/2021, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is approved and adopted and shall become effective at the beginning of the 2020/2021 fiscal year and the District's funds may be expended commencing October 1, 2020.
- 2. The proposed expenditures in the final water and wastewater utility enterprise fund budget are \$ 6,562,194. The budget is based upon the total revenue for operating purposes of \$ 6,562,194.
- 3. Funds of the District's 2020/2021 final water and wastewater utility enterprise fund budget not expended during the current fiscal year 2020/2021 may be used and expended during subsequent fiscal years.
- 4. The Budget set forth on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution shall become effective on October 1, 2020.
- 5. If any one or more of the provisions of this resolution or the exhibit attached hereto shall be held contrary to any express provision of law or contrary to the policy of express law, though not expressly prohibited or against public policy, or shall for any reason whatsoever be held invalid, then such provision shall be null and void and shall be separate from the remaining provisions, and shall in no way affect the validity of all other provisions of this resolution or the exhibit attached hereto.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
